

Privacy Policy

The Center for Responsible Outdoor Activities and Recreation (hereafter referred to as ROAR) is committed to respecting your privacy. In order to provide you with important information, programs and services, we sometimes request that you provide us with data about yourself. This policy applies to all ROAR websites that may be used in the future. You should also note that ROAR maintains the same privacy practices with respect to data that is collected off-line.

ROAR is not responsible for the privacy policies, practices or content of third party websites listed or linked to on ROAR's site or materials.

Collection of Personally Identifiable Information

In general, you may visit ROAR's website without identifying yourself or revealing any personal information.

Some portions of this website may request that you give us personally identifiable information, which is information that enables us to identify you, such as your name, email or other address. Some of the ways we may collect information from you are through:

Use of Personally Identifiable Information

ROAR may use your personally identifiable information to contact you periodically with information relevant to ROAR programs, services and membership you request. This includes newsletters, renewal notices, and other relevant communication.

As part of its resources program, ROAR gives others an option to make their contact information available for individuals who are interested in utilizing their services. Such information could be collected and disclosed by others and ROAR does not take responsibility for such collection or disclosure. Those who elect to place their contact information on the ROAR website can have that information removed from the site at any time by contacting dgale@tcfroar.org.

ROAR may disclose personally identifiable information that it collects if required to do so by law or when necessary in order to protect the rights of ROAR, it's volunteers, or it's employee's.

Other Information Collected Through Technology

In addition to information you choose to provide us, we also collect non-personally identifiable information through technology to make our site more relevant and useful. When you come to our site, we collect your Internet Protocol ("IP") address. An IP address is often associated with

the portal through which you enter the Internet, like your ISP (Internet service provider). Standing alone, your IP address is not personally identifiable. At times, we use IP addresses to collect information regarding the frequency with which our visitors visit various parts of our sites. We may combine this information with other information that is publicly available or that we receive from other reputable sources in order to make our website and communications more targeted to your interests.
